## REGISTRATION OPTIONS

Grades 1-5
In-Person Formation: Classes are offered at two different times on Mondays. Classes meet in the School and Gathering Area. Grades 1-3 will use St. Mary's Press Discover Program. Grades 4-5 do theme and activity based programming.
Home Formation: During baptism, parents agree to be the primary educators of the faith to their children. This program allows you to do that with the support of the Faith Formation office. Families will need to pick up packets twice with materials and activities to teach your child at home. If you do not pick up your packet, the next set will not be made for you unless you request it. Families will be required to participate in Family Activity Nights and to periodic check ins.

## Grades 6 through Confirmation In-Person Formation:

The various programs offered for students in grades 6-11 are meant to be done in community with peers and adult leaders. Grades 6-8 will use St. Mary's Press Connect and gather on Wednesdays starting in the Gathering Area. The 9th graders, meet in small groups, and will explore Catholic Social Teaching topics such as, respect for all, service for others, and that all people are to love and to be loved. Young people preparing for Confirmation use Chosen from Ascension Press to determine their readiness for the Sacrament and discover why choosing Jesus and the Church matters.

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO KNOW

- Students are placed in classes in the order in which completed registrations and payment are received in the parish office AND small group leader availability. We can not do this without your help! There will be NO MORE THAN 10 students per group with an adult. Once groups are full, students will be placed on a waiting list until more small group leaders come forward.
- Registration is for ALL YOUTH in grades 1-10 and for First Reconciliation, First Eucharist and Confirmation.
- There is limited space in each of the Monday afternoon and evening sessions. Please register early to ensure your child's placement in the session of your choice.
- Classes will be formed based on those registered by May 15th. Families new to SFX are welcome at any time, of course!

## SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

First Reconciliation, First Eucharist and Confirmation materials fee is $\$ 55.00$ per person in addition to the regular fees above. Please pay these fees when making your registration payment.

Parent volunteers are VITAL to the success of our programs! Receive a $\$ 110.00$ credit when you volunteer in certain areas. See the volunteer form for more information.

FEES OR PAYMENT PLAN FORM ARE DUE AT THE TIME OF REGISTRATION
Fees can be paid by cash, check or online by credit card on the parish website. Click on the Donate/Payments button at the top. Please make sure to select Faith Formation Payment. Monthly payment plans can be set up by filling out a monthly automatic withdrawal form. (Available in the Faith Formation Office)

If you have a financial concern please contact the Faith Formation Office. We want all children to participate regardless of ability to pay. However, you must contact the Faith Formation Office immediately or your registration will not be processed.
**Students are placed in classes in the order in which COMPLETED registration and payment are received in the Faith Formation Office AND based on small group leader availability.

Completed means: Registration Form has been submitted and payment or a payment plan or waiver is received.

## SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

First Reconciliation/First Eucharist is a two year preparation process beginning no earlier than first grade. Children are eligible for these sacraments in their second year of Faith Formation. In the second year of preparation, parents are required to participate in informational meetings, parent/child retreats and work with their child at home in addition to the children participating in a Faith Formation Program or Catholic School.

Confirmation preparation may begin in the 10th grade year, but not earlier. Youth must successfully complete their 9th grade year in either Faith Formation or Catholic School. If you did not complete 9th grade Faith Formation, contact Melissa ASAP to receive make up materials. Preparation begins in the fall of 10th grade and students are confirmed in the fall of their 11th grade year. Preparation for Confirmation includes: parent meeting, parent/candidate orientation session, parent/candidate large group sessions, retreat, monthly classes, sponsor sessions, and service. The Confirmation Sacrament fee covers both their 10th and 11th grade year as students do not reregister in 11th grade.
